Beethoven: Symphony No.4

Charles Lambert: The Rio Grande (Soloists: Shan Liu, piano & Hannah Morgan, alto)

David Hamilton: Peace, My Heart

One doesn't often see a Beethoven symphony opening a concert programme – but the composer's 4th symphony is a light and cheerful work, with a pervading spirit of optimism.

The second half of the programme features *The Rio Grande* by English composer Charles Lambert. It was first performed in 1929 and is not unlike the style of Gershwin's *Rhapsody in Blue*. Its syncopation and dynamic Latin American dance rhythms, together with a full symphony orchestra and 120-voice choir, create a vibrant listening experience! The work demands no fewer than 5 percussionists to perform the captivating rhythms on an exciting range of instruments. The dazzling piano part is performed by Shan Liu, with alto soloist Hannah Morgan.

Peace, My Heart is a short work written in 2021 by David Hamilton, who is one of NZ's best known and most-performed composers. The work has been re-scored this year for a mixed choir and symphony orchestra, especially for this concert series. Listen out for the percussion here too!

The Conductors –

Croatian-born Music Director **Antun Poljanich**, a conducting graduate of the Rimsky-Korsakov Conservatory in Leningrad, has conducted AYO since 1999. **David Squire**, Music Director of AYC and one of NZ's most prominent choral conductors, is in demand as a conductor, adjudicator and presenter both here and abroad.
